












# **MINI GRANTS**

Mini Grants were recently awarded to 21 WNH departments. Mini Grant contributions, which come directly from funds donated by people like you, totaled \$14,102.84, and an additional \$4,272.14 from the hospital will cover remaining costs for individual requests. # WHAT DO YOUR DONATIONS MEAN TO THE WNH SANE DEPARTMENT?

"Our WNHF Mini Grant has allowed us to procure updated equipment that will make exams much more efficient, safe, and calming for sexual assault patients. Part of our grant will purchase a foot pedal to operate our camera, allowing for hands-free camera operation while caring for the patient. We will also purchase new clothes for patients that are appropriate for all seasons, so we don't have people exiting the hospital after an exam wearing sweatpants/ sweatshirts in the summer. The SANE Department is not a moneymaking department, but it is a very important healthcare service to our community.
