- ▶ Central Supply Warehouse – Roofing is currently in process of installation along with interior electrical wiring and plumbing lines. Central Supply project completion is scheduled for 21-June.
- ▶ Operating Room Exterior Walls – Crews are working to lift the forms in support of the additional height of concrete walls. Concrete pour is scheduled for Monday 25-March.
- ▶ Temporary Operating Recovery(PACU) Room – Construction renovation is completed and be ready for occupancy utilization on Tuesday 26-March.
